

Sheila Hollie Memorial Scholarship Application

The Sheila Hollie Memorial Scholarship is available to residents of the Greenway neighborhood in Fort Worth for undergraduate education or technical schooling beyond high school. It is in memory of Sheila Hollie, who was a long-time resident of the Greenway neighborhood and a board member and active participant in the 6:8 Project.

Candidates interested in applying for the Sheila Hollie Scholarship need to apply in writing, using this application.

Requirements:

1. Only *residents of the Greenway neighborhood* in Fort Worth are eligible to apply.
2. Scholarship is only available for *undergraduate education or technical schooling beyond high school*. The scholarship is available to students who are currently taking classes as well as students who are applying to such institutions.

An independent committee nominated by the 6:8 Project Board of Directors will evaluate

1. **the potential success of each student applicant and**
2. **the potential need and impact of the scholarship funds based on the information given in the application and subsequently verified.**

Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection and award amount as soon as possible. The amount of the award and the number of awards given will depend on the available funds and the quality of the applications. Scholarships will be evaluated and awarded quarterly, with payments made directly to the college or technical school. The due dates for quarterly submissions are January 20, April 20, July 20, October 20.

La Beca Conmemorativa Sheila Hollie está disponible para los residentes del vecindario de Greenway en Fort Worth para educación subgraduada o educación técnica más allá de la escuela secundaria. Es en memoria de Sheila Hollie, que fue una residente de muchos años del vecindario de Greenway y miembro de la junta y participante activa en el Proyecto 6:8.

Los candidatos interesados en solicitar la Beca Sheila Hollie deben solicitar por escrito, utilizando esta solicitud.

Requisitos:

1. Solo *los residentes del vecindario de Greenway* en Fort Worth son elegibles para solicitar.
2. La beca sólo está disponible para *la educación subgraduada o la educación técnica más allá de la escuela secundaria*. La beca está disponible para los estudiantes que actualmente están tomando clases, así como los estudiantes que están solicitando a tales instituciones.

Un comité independiente designado por la Junta de Directores del Proyecto 6:8 evaluará

1. **el potencial de éxito de cada estudiante solicitante y**
2. **la necesidad potencial y el impacto de los fondos de las becas, basado en la información proporcionada en la solicitud y verificada posteriormente.**

Los beneficiarios de la beca serán notificados de su selección y el monto de la concesión tan pronto como sea posible. El importe del premio y el número de premios otorgados dependerán de los fondos disponibles y de la calidad de las solicitudes.

Las becas serán evaluadas y premiadas trimestralmente, con pagos realizados directamente a la universidad o escuela técnica. Las fechas de vencimiento para las solicitudes trimestrales son el 20 de enero, el 20 de abril, el 20 de julio y el 20 de octubre.
